The magnificence of nature is a frequent influence in Linda Thiemann's fiber art. She finds deep spirituality in how these elements were created, so she brings these aspects to the forefront of her contemporary fiber art.

Linda Thiemann is an alumna of Grinnell College, where she majored in fine art. She brings many years of corporate experience to her business, since devoting herself full time to her art in 2005. Linda is a member of The Dallas Area Fiber Artists, The Texas Visual Arts Association, and The Texas Sculpture Association.
